Round 3 Who of a kind x 5 I'll describe 2 people or characters involved in Doctor Who who share the same initials – name both for a point each.

- 1 Person 1 is the actress who played 2<sup>nd</sup> Doctor companion Victora Waterfield and person 2 is the first story editor of Doctor Who, he also wrote classic stories including The Rescue, The Crusade and The Evil of the Daleks, the aforementioned Simon Guerrier published a book about him in 2023
- 2 Person 1 is the character played by Bonnie Langford, companion of the 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> Doctors. Person 2 is the children's author who co-wrote the story 'Rosa' from 2018 starring the 13<sup>th</sup> Doctor.
- 3 Person 1 is a director who directed various stories from 1963 up to 1979, these include the original Daleks episodes, Robot and The Creature from the Pit. Person 2 is a writer who wrote The Face of Evil, The Robots of Death and Image of the Fendahl, he also worked on Blake's 7

4 Person 1 was the musical director and composer of music for the series from 2005 to 2017 and he rejoined with Russell T Davies in 2023. Person 2 is the actress who played 13<sup>th</sup> Doctor companion Yasmin Khan.

5 and finally Person is the actor who played 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> doctor companion Adric, one of the only companions to die in the series. Person 2 is an actor who played an number of characters in the series including some Dalek voices, but is perhaps best known as the original (and best) Davros in Genesis of the Daleks in 1975.
